University Exploration Program

During the workshops, students engage in hands-on learning, participate in interactive sessions, and explore real university environments that support planning for future study pathways. The program also offers the opportunity to earn a Certificate of Completion from selected courses, providing tangible achievements to strengthen school and university applications.



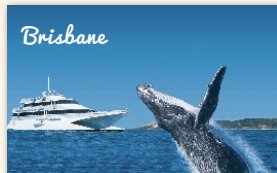

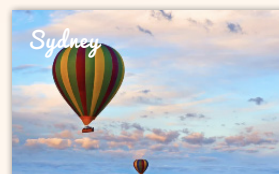
